Educational Awards


For almost 100 years, Zonta International, in conjunction with various United Nations agencies, has provided financial support and technical assistance to women and children in developing countries.

- Amelia Earhart Fellowship Awards apply to graduate study in aerospace-related sciences and engineering.
- Young Women in Public Affairs Award encourages young women to seek leadership positions in public service and civic causes.
- The Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarship supports women pursuing undergraduate and master's degrees in business management.

In addition to supporting Zonta International educational awards, Central Oklahoma offers educational awards in STEM (Science Technology Engineering Math) and Zonta Educational Memoriam Award supporting an Oklahoma female student.

Zonta International Strategies to End Violence Against Women program supports international service projects that promote and protect the human rights of all women and girls and work to end gender-based violence worldwide.

International Service

The Zonta International Service Program focuses on projects that help women in developing countries improve their legal, political, economic, educational and health status.

Zonta helps women and girls overcome gender barriers to educational and professional advancement; provides opportunities for women to earn higher wages and achieve economic independence; ensures that women and children have access to quality, affordable health care; and strives to end violence against women while helping survivors rebuild their lives.

Local Service

The Zonta Club of Central Oklahoma raises funds to provide support to organizations that align with our mission. Two thirds of the club's fundraising revenues support local service projects such as YWCA Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners, Neighborhood Service Organization, Oklahoma Project Woman and the Dragonfly Home. The local projects considered for funding are voted on by the membership and then awarded to various organizations.

In addition, our club participates in various quarterly service projects, PIVOT-Youth Services of Oklahoma County and Oklahoma Coalition Against Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault. The service projects are funded through individual donations by club members. We also help Habitat for Humanity through the Women's Build program, women helping other women.
