SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

We are seeking sponsors for our Nineteenth Annual Zonta Fall Classic Golf Tournament on October 2, 2026 at FireLake Golf Course. We have four tiers of sponsorship opportunities.

Tier I, Corporate Sponsor: \$1500. A Corporate Sponsor receives an entry for a team of four and a prominently displayed banner (if supplied by the sponsor), in addition to a prominently displayed sponsor sign on a hole alone or in a high traffic area.

Tier II, Hole in One Sponsor: \$500. A Hole in One Sponsor has their sponsor sign displayed on its own at one of the course holes.

Tier III, Eagle Sponsor: \$250. An Eagle Sponsor has their sponsor sign displayed with no more than two other sponsor signs at one of the course holes.

Tier IV, Par Sponsor: \$100. A Par Sponsor has their sponsor sign displayed with other Par Sponsors at one of the course holes.

In addition to the opportunity to lend support to local and international projects that promote the objects of Zonta, sponsors will benefit from the exposure our tournament provides. This exposure includes being listed by Tier on the Sponsor Program that will be included in each golfer's swag bag, as well as the opportunity to promote your organization through provided sponsor signs, in concert with the Zonta cause, at our well-attended tournament.

History

In 2019, we celebrated our 100th anniversary and the milestones that made us the organization we are today. 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HOW ZONTA CLUB OF CENTRAL OKLAHOMA SUPPORTS THE ZONTA MISSION

The Zonta Club of Central Oklahoma is a member of Zonta International. To the promote the ideals and objects of Zonta, the Zonta Club of Central Oklahoma donates one-third of its fundraising profits to Zonta Foundation for Women and distributes two-thirds of its fundraising profits locally through educational awards and donations to local, like-minded, service organizations. In 2026, the Zonta Club of Central Oklahoma donated funds to: The Dragonfly Home (Human Trafficking Survivor Services), Neighborhood Services Organization, Cardinal Point Family Justice Center, Period OKC, Precious Pearls of Ardmore, Oklahoma Project Woman and YWCA (Forensic Nursing Program). The club also made funds available toward educational awards to further studies in areas such as public service, STEM, and business.

ZONTA CLUB OF CENTRAL OKLAHOMA FUNDRAISING HISTORY

Prior to 2008 our fundraising efforts were based on the personal sales efforts of our club members. We made items that could be sold as gifts for Valentine's Day, Mother's Day and Administrative Assistant Day and sold pecans. The effort required for these projects was great while the profits were small.

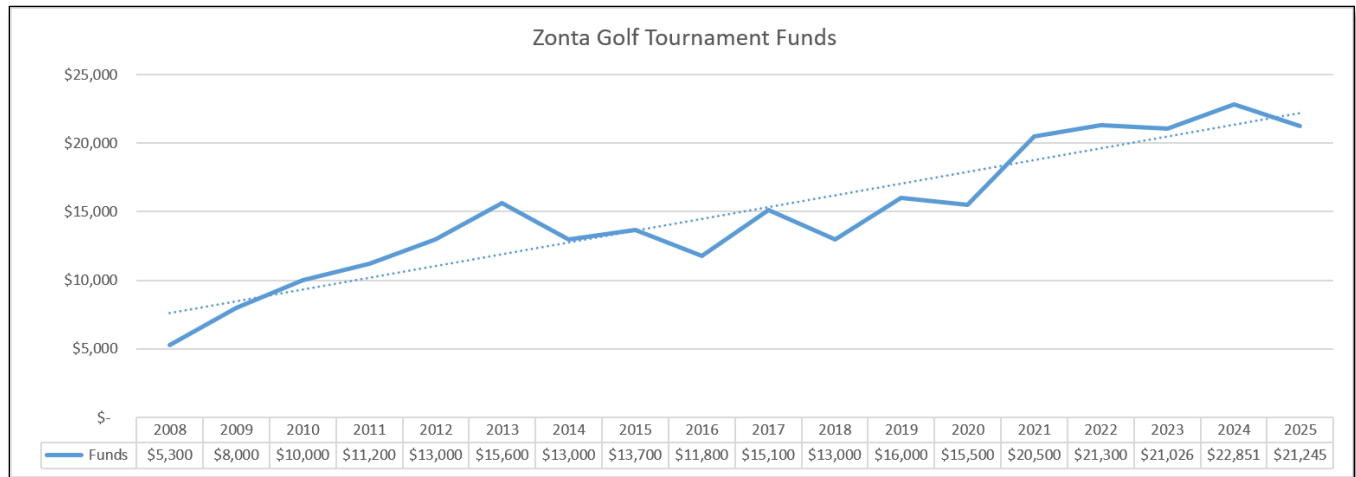
In 2008 we took a different approach and launched our inaugural Fall Classic Golf Tournament. We considered the tournament a success with a profit of \$5,336. The profit from this one effort amounted to more profit than we normally made through all our previous fundraising projects combined on an annual basis. For this reason, we have continued to focus on our Annual Fall Classic Golf Tournament as our primary fundraising event.

Currently, our golf tournament profits are derived from a combination of funds from team fees, and sponsorships gained from the efforts of individual member solicitation. Individual members take our golf tournament materials, which include an advertising flyer, letter explaining how the funds from the tournament will be utilized and club brochure to solicit sponsorships. The graph below details our Golf Tournament Profit History and shows that our members have been successful at increasing our profits – primarily through an increase in individual sponsors.

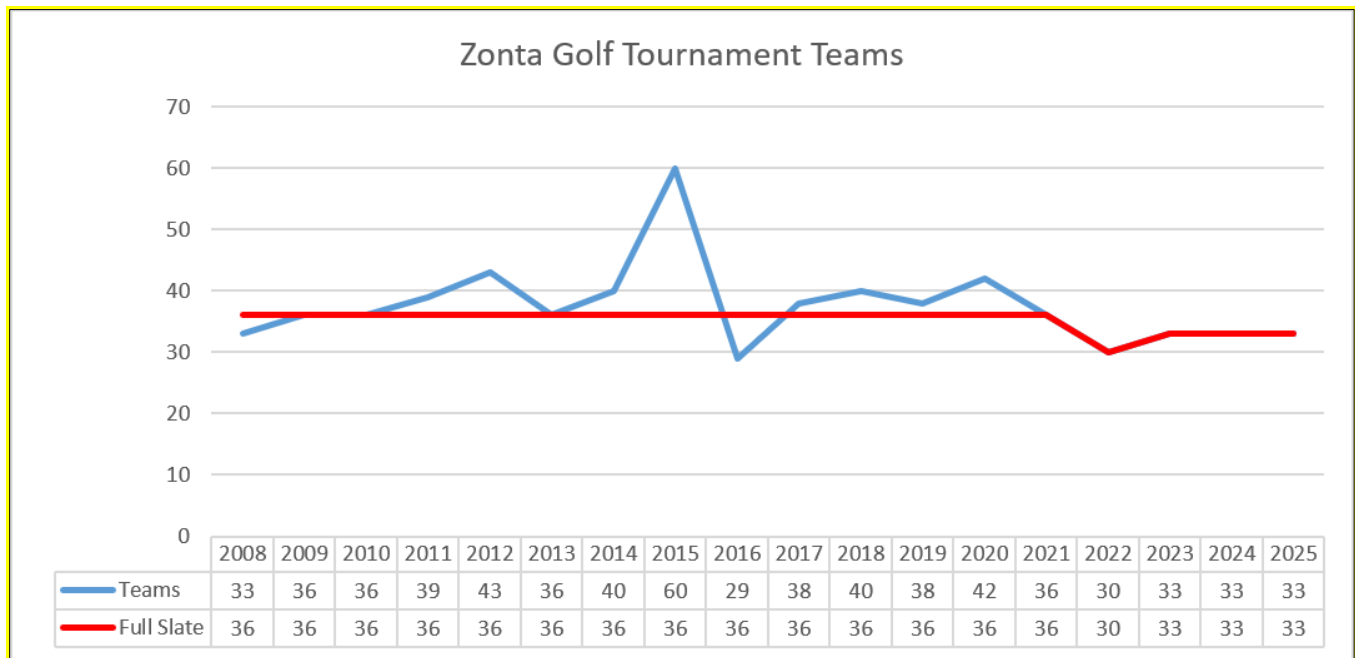
